

TOWN OF GARFIELD
2nd Street Water Line
to be Replaced
Construction begins
Week of Jan. 25th!



In late 2009, the Town of Garfield was awarded a Recovery Act Grant for replacing the old 4" water pipe along 2nd Street with an 8" line. The line to be replaced runs from California Street to and across the school ball field. Keltic Engineering has been working on the plans since last fall. The contractor for the project is M&L Construction. Because the weather has been so mild these last weeks, M&L plans to start work by the middle of next week. They will be working along both sides of the street, depending upon the water line route, as well as working under the railroad tracks. They are anticipating a Monday through Thursday work week.

Please know the Town, Keltic Engineering and M&L Construction are committed to making this project as least disruptive to your normal schedule as possible. There will be times that part of the road will be closed, perhaps up to 2 blocks at a time, but every effort will be made to reopen the road as quickly as possible. No extended water service interruption is anticipated. There will be minor shut off periods for reconnections, etc.
