The Garfield-Palouse School Districts provide bus driver training at no cost to candidates. This entails (2) days of classroom training set up by state certified Bus Driver Instructor, Marvin Pillers. In addition, you set your own schedule for driving practice with Marvin Pillers.

To be eligible you must:

- 1) Have no more than 2 tickets in the last 5 years.
- 2) Submit and pass an initial and random drug test (No fee, we provide this at the school)
- 3) Submit and pass a fingerprint screening and criminal background check (Cost APPRX \$43.50)
- 4) Be able to obtain and pass a DOT physical (Cost APPRX \$100)
- 5) Pass written tests for the following drivers license endorsements: Commercial Driver's License Class B, Airbrakes, Passenger, and School Bus Driver (Cost APPRX \$17 each)
- 6) Pass CDL driving, backing and pre-trip test (Cost APPRX \$100)
