REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING FOLLOWING:

CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Pfaff called meeting to order at 7:02pm

INTRODUCTION OF GUESTS: Chief Neumann, Officer Anderson

APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES:

Cande Hasenoehrl **MOVED** to approve the minutes from October 10th, 2018 council meeting, Neal Leon **seconded**, the motion passed unanimously

POLICE REPORT: Chief Neumann available for report.

Officer Handley turned in a letter of resignation – Last day will be 8:00 on Sunday, Oct 28th.

Officer Anderson is working with the owner of vehicles on E. California Street. The cars should begin getting removed Oct 26th, 2018, and they will continue to monitor the situation. Officer Anderson was able to locate a tow company that will be able to remove them.

Chief Neumann asked the council if they were considering dropping the Interlocal Agreement for police service.

Mayor Pfaff responded to Chief Neumann saying that it will need to be discussed in an executive session.

PUBLIC WORKS REPORT: Shon Clark available for report.

Installed water meter boxes at storage sheds, they were only covered by a sheet of metal which would get scraped off by snow plows.

Meter reads were done.

Mark and Shon attended sewer activated sludge class in Airway Heights.

Installed stair case to bio cell at sewer plant.

Diana from DOE visited the sewer plant, she was very satisfied with what they are doing and all the accomplishments that have been done.

2 compost bins have been filled, more to haul.

PW is working on filling second scrap metal bin.

Currently in process of getting all equipment ready for winter.

Garbage is being picked up on time

Repaired a bent hydraulic cylinder on Currotto-can, looking at getting it replaced

Ackerman's were in town and serviced the Methodist Church furnace. Furnace is in good condition.

OLD BUSINESS:

Meetings during holiday season – after discussion Neal Leon **MOVED** to have the meetings remain as scheduled for November, and the meetings in December would be December 12th & the 19th. Cande Hasenoehrl **seconded**, and the motion passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mayor Pfaff brought up a purchase of a UTV for the Public Works Department. The cost of the UTV would be approximately \$14,000 and a snow blade would be \$3,000. Financing is available for the purchase. Mark Young **MOVED** to make the purchase and use by using the financing option. Tom Tevlin **seconded** the motion and it passed unanimously.

FINANCIAL: Approval of bills to be paid – Neal Leon **MOVED** to pay the bills, and Cande Hasenoehrl **seconded** the motion and it passed unanimously.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: Mark Young **MOVED** to enter an executive decision at 7:40 pm and Cande Hasenoehrl **seconded** the motion and it passed unanimously. Cande Hasenoehrl **MOVED** to exit the session, Neal Leon **seconded**, and the session ended at 7:50 pm.
