CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Pfaff called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

ROLL CALL: Mayor Pfaff, David Ulrick, Cande Hasenoehrl, Neal Leon, Mark Young, Tom Tevlin, Officer Snead, Chief Neumann. Staff: Nancy Whitesell – Clerk/Treasurer, Public Works – Shon Clark

INTRODUCTION OF GUESTS: Roger Million, Laurie Meyer

Roger Million asked if his neighbor is clear as to where he can put his fence. He doesn't want to have to pull up the posts again, since it was incorrectly located the first time. Mayor Pfaff stated that he made the resident aware of the acceptable location.

APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES: September 11th, 2019 Regular Council Meeting. Cande Hasenoehrl **MOVED** to approve the minutes. Neal Leon seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

POLICE REPORT: Chief Neumann updated the Town on a resident that had been arrested 2 months ago. He is still working with the ATF regarding the case. Roger Million asked how the clearing of the trailer park is going. Mayor Pfaff stated we have 4 people left that the Town is working with to vacate their lots.

PUBLIC WORKS REPORT: Shon Clark to report: Public Works assisted the Community Church with a water leak. They continued to do more smoke testing and found a major resource for the water entering the sewer system. They will begin to work on that. Cleared more right of ways on South Hill for the garbage truck. Town clean up went well, with the normal amount of trash based on past pick-ups. Town is benefited by the railroad work that is being done. They've received good backfill material from when they took 2nd Street crossing. They were able to get 7 loads.

OLD BUSINESS: Mayor Pfaff updated Council on the progress of the trailer court. 2 of them should be out by the end of the week. Another is having trouble moving her trailer. Preliminary conversation with a mover estimates that it will be about \$8000a trailer to move them. Looking at other ways to make it happen. Chief Neumann suggested possibly asking Gage Brothers to do it. Neal Leon asked about the restaurant. Mayor Pfaff said he is still in conversation with someone who wants to use it as a catering kitchen. The house on 4th Street, that several people have complained about has finally been cleaned up. Fire District has begun their budget discussions. Discussion as to a lid lift vs a levy took place. Mayor Pfaff asked them to consider annexing into the district, the same as the Library. The Clerk for the Fire Department gave her notice tonight at their meeting.

NEW BUSINESS: Mayor Pfaff stated that the daycare is closing. They're currently down to one full time child and 3 part time children. The school is unwilling to fund it. October will be the last month that it will be open. They are looking into after school program and/or other types of options.

David Ulrick stated that we need to schedule meeting dates for November and December to cover the holidays. David Ulrick **MOVED** to have meetings November 6th and 20th, and December 4th and if needed, again on the 18th. Cande Hasenoehrl seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

FINANCIAL: Approval of checks – Dave Ulrick **MOVED** to approve payment of checks. Neal Leon seconded, and the motion passed.

ADJOURN: Cande Hasenoehrl **MOVED** to adjourn the meeting. Neal seconded, and the motion passed unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 7:44 pm.
