CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Pfaff called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

ROLL CALL: Mayor Pfaff, David Ulrick, Cande Hasenoehrl, Neal Leon, Mark Young, Chief Neumann. Staff: Nancy Whitesell – Clerk/Treasurer, Public Works – Shon Clark

INTRODUCTION OF GUESTS: Connie Schaut, Larry Kruse Ed Zubiata

Larry Kruse stated that a few people have come up to him complaining of the condition of the town. No one mowing their lawns, and the right of ways are out of control. They have become fire hazards in his opinion. He and other citizens feel that something needs to be done. Wants the city to either contact the owners of the property, or even have the city take care of them, to set an example. Mayor Pfaff stated he will check into it and take a tour of the town.

Ed Zubiata gave an update on his moving situation. He stated he is in the process of buying a place and will hopefully be out of the trailer court this weekend or sometime next week.

APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES: August 28th, 2019 Regular Council Meeting. Cande Hasenoehrl **MOVED** to approve the minutes with a change of date from approving August 28th minutes to August 14th. Mark Young seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

POLICE REPORT: Chief Neumann to report: Today is in remembrance of 9/11 and the victims. We lost 343 fire fighters, 60 police officers, 43 medics and just under 3000 citizens. He has spoken to the ATF regarding the illegal weaponry found at a household in town. The items are still in the evidence lab at the review stage. An animal complaint morphed into threats, which then turned into notice to remove animal. Chief Neumann believes the dog was removed voluntarily.

PUBLIC WORKS REPORT: Shon Clark to report: Repaired water leak on service line on 3rd St. Began installation for new service on Cleveland Street. Removed and rebuilt the check valve for 3 Well. Continued planting Bull Rush plants in sewer polishing cell. Installed 3 flow meters and dyed some roof drains for the I&I study. Installed sprinkler system isolation valve at the park so that the area of the leak can dry up, while leaving service to the bathroom.
