REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING FOLLOWING:

CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Pfaff called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm

ROLL CALL: Mayor Pfaff, Mark Young, Neal Leon, David Ulrick, Cande Hasenoehrl. Officer Anderson. Staff: Nancy Whitesell – Clerk/Treasurer

INTRODUCTION OF GUESTS: Amanda Argona, Dana Hogan, Blake Clemens, Terilynn Manzano, Andrea Mills, Beverly Spencer, Guy Spencer

Amanda Argona discussed the community interest in creating an ongoing farmer's market. She stated it currently is in the planning stage. Members of the group wanted to make sure the Town was ok with it. Mayor Pfaff and council members approved the market and thought it was a good idea.

APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES: April 10, 2019 Regular Council Meeting. Cande Hasenoehrl **MOVED** to approve the minutes. Neal Leon seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

POLICE REPORT: Officer Anderson to report. There have been a couple verbal DV calls, no arrests. There was also a DV assault, however the person had left the scene before Officer Cox could get there, and they were not a resident of Garfield. Officer Cox is patrolling on his own, and has been Access certified, therefore he is legal to run names, license plates, guns. Officers Anderson Snead and Cox will have AED training.

PUBLIC WORKS REPORT: Mayor Pfaff to report: Andy O'Neill found a used UV system for the sewer plant in Kittitas County. We could change SO2 to UV, which could be a savings for the Town. He is having Steve Nelson from Century West look into the cost to switch. The new camera for the sewer is working very well. Public Works is looking into buying some Echo blocks for different bunkers for gravel; looking at different options regarding cost. The picnic tables are done, and they are working on the merry go round. Public works have also raised man holes, and exposed manholes that were paved over. They will be looking for sump pumps draining into the sewer lines also identifying man holes so they know where to look when the flow is high to see

if the places have sump pumps running in. The new camera allows them to see where the water is coming from.

OLD BUSINESS: Cande Hasenoehrl asked Mayor Pfaff about the contract for the daycare. Mayor Pfaff is still working on this. She also asked about weed control this summer. Mayor Pfaff indicated that PW could contact Larry Hunt for a bid. Cande asked the Mayor if he could include down town as well. Cande asked about 3 people working on Spring Clean day. Mayor Pfaff reminded her that \$3500 had been set aside for additional help for Public works.
