REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING FOLLOWING:

CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Pfaff called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm

ROLL CALL: Mayor Pfaff, Mark Young, Neal Leon, David Ulrick, Cande Hasenoehrl, Chief Neumann, Officer Cox. Staff: Nancy Whitesell – Clerk/Treasurer, Public Works – Shon Clark

INTRODUCTION OF GUESTS:

APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES: April 24th, 2019 Regular Council Meeting. Cande Hasenoehrl **MOVED** to approve the minutes. Neal Leon seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

POLICE REPORT: Chief Neumann to report: They are getting geared up for May Day. They will set cones and close the streets between 8:00 – 8:30. Officer Anderson has been working on the junk vehicles around town. A resident of Garfield was arrested over the weekend for possession of drugs. Chief Neumann stated that they will be watching the location near his residence. David Ulrick asked if there had been any complaints about drug paraphernalia in the park. Chief Neumann stated that he had not heard of anything.

PUBLIC WORKS REPORT: Shon Clark to report: Public Works has replaced two 2-inch water meters and a 1 ¾ inch meter. Had an after hours call and were able to get the customer back in service. They have been videoing all the sewer mains trying to identify infiltration. They identified a few leaks, but nothing major yet. The Parks are dry and looking good. The merry-go-round has been repaired and painted, and the bench swing will be replaced after a volunteer finishes repairing it. Shon is hoping to get the streets swept during the upcoming rain that has been forecasted for next week. If it doesn't rain, they will look for an alternative to have them done before May Day. A new muffler for the garbage truck has been purchase and will be put on the garbage truck as soon as time allows.

OLD BUSINESS: Mayor Pfaff had Council look at the bid from Larry Hunt; the bid is for spraying weeds in different locations in town. The Town would be billed \$420 each time he sprays. Cande Hasenoehrl asked if we needed it done 3 times, and discussion continued. Tom Tevlin **MOVED** to approve this bid for twice this year and Council will readdress if we need it again for the third time. Mark Young seconded, and the motion passed unanimously. In addition to the regular areas of spraying, Larry Hunt will spray other areas in town including Town Hall for \$950 for each application. Mayor Pfaff indicated that Larry thought it should be done 3 times. After some discussion, Cande Hasenoehrl **MOVED** that the spraying gets done twice and Council will address the 3rd application later. Tom Tevlin seconded, and the motion passed unanimously. Cande Hasenoehrl asked the Mayor where he was at with the daycare agreement. Mayor Pfaff stated that the attorney is in the process of writing it up.

NEW BUSINESS: Resolution with Certification of Compliance 2019-04 indicates conditions that need to be met to receive CDBG funds. Tom Tevlin **MOVED** to pass the resolution. Neal Leon seconded, and the motion passed unanimously. Mayor Pfaff reminded council members Mark Young, Neal Leon and David Ulrick that it is time for them to file if they're going to run for reelection. Nancy Whitesell reported that a resident had a water leak over the winter and was asking for relief on their bill. Council agreed that payments could be made in addition to the regular monthly payments without receiving a late fee on the past due balance.

FINANCIAL: Neal Leon **MOVED** to approve the checks. Mark Young seconded, and the motion passed.

ADJOURN: Cande Hasenoehrl **MOVED** to adjourn the meeting. Neal Leon seconded, and the motion passed unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 7:20 pm
